INTERVENTION ORDER

The Board of Directors of Dirigo Health Agency has received applications to intervene from: the Maine State Chamber of Commerce (the “Chamber”) dated May 19, 2009; Maine Automobile Dealers Association Insurance Trust (“MADAIT”) dated May 7, 2009; the Maine Association of Health Plans (“MAHP”) dated May 22, 2009; and Anthem Health Plans of Maine (“Anthem”) dated May 21, 2009.

The Chamber, MADAIT, MAHP and Anthem (the “Intervenors”) have participated in prior proceedings before the Board on the determination of aggregate measurable cost savings and have demonstrated that they will be substantially and directly affected by the current proceeding.

The applications of the Chamber, MADAIT, MAHP and Anthem are granted as of right under 5 M. R. S. A. § 9054 (1).

As parties to the proceeding, the intervenors shall be bound by all procedural requirements set forth in Dirigo Health Agency Rule Chapter 4 and all procedural orders issued by the Board during the course of this proceeding.

The Board requires that parties with similar interests to consolidate presentations of evidence and argument at the hearing. Accordingly, parties with similar interests shall, among other matters, coordinate the use of experts and the testimony of witnesses and issues to be addressed at the hearing.

In the Procedural Order No. 1, dated May 20, 2009, the Board appointed William H. Laubenstein, III, AAG, to serve as hearing officer. Attorney Laubenstein has notified the Board that he is unable to serve as hearing officer. The Board will notify parties upon the appointment of another hearing officer. The Board understands that Attorney Laubenstein will be serving as co-counsel for the Dirigo Health Agency with Attorney Colleran in this matter.
