As required by the Procedural Order of June 24, 2008, the Dirigo Health Agency states that the following issues are to be determined by the Board in this proceeding:

- 1. The amount of savings in State Fiscal Year 2007 attributed to Maine hospitals' voluntary reduction in cost per Case Mix Adjusted Discharge ("CMAD");
- 2. The amount of savings in Calendar Year 2008 attributed to the reduction or avoidance of bad debt and charity care costs;
- 3. The amount of savings in Calendar Year 2008 attributed to the implementation of a minimum Medical Loss Ratio ("MLR") requirement for the small group insurance market; and
 - 4. The aggregate amount of the above savings.

There are many issues that the Board is *not* to determine in this proceeding, including the following that are addressed at length in some of Intervenors' proposed pre-filed testimony:

- 1. What the Savings Offset Payment ("SOP") will be for the fourth assessment year;
- 2. What portion of the savings is reasonably recoverable by the payers of the SOP;
- 3. What the payers can or should do to attempt to recover savings;
- 4. What the payers can or should do if they are unable to fully recover savings; and

5. Whether it makes sense from a policy perspective for the payers to pay the SOP or for them to pass part or all of the SOP on to their policy holders or others.
